(Must be a son/daughter of an *active* PBA Member)

Eligibility Requirements (all criteria must be met to be considered):

- 1. Applicant must be a child of an active South Florida PBA member with a minimum of one-year membership or have prior Board approval. <u>Children of retirees are not eligible to apply.</u>
- 2. Applicant must be or plan to be, a part-time or full-time student at an accredited trade school or a two-year or four-year college. <u>Graduate students are not eligible to apply. Maximum age for applicant is 24 years of age (applicants who are under 24 as of December 31, 2024, may apply)</u>
- 3. Applicant must include an essay that Reflects on a time when someone helped you or made a significant impact in your life. How do you plan to 'pay it forward' in your community or field of study? Minimum of 400 words, maximum of 750 words. The essay must be typed, double-spaced, using 12-point Arial or Times New Roman font only. Please include a header or footer with name and page number.
- Send application, essay, headshot photograph, and letter of acceptance (first-time applicants only) and a transcript with GPA in one package to: South Florida PBA Scholarship Committee, 10680 PBA Memorial Blvd. (NW 25th Street), Doral, FL 33172.

DO NOT submit resumes and letters of recommendation. DO NOT bind in any way.

Disqualification:

Should the recipient of a scholarship fail to enroll and/or attend a qualifying college program within eigh
(8) months after receipt of award, the full amount of the scholarship shall be returned to its appropriate
fund or, otherwise, be subject to collection.

Is application typed clearly with contact phone number and email fo applicant?
Is the application signed on page 2 by both the applicant and parent?
Is essay included, double-spaced in 12-point Arial or Times New Romar font with a minimum of 400 words maximum of 750?
Is Letter of Acceptance (applicable to High School Seniors or first-time applicants only) included?
Is transcript from High School or Trade School or College included?
Is a headshot photograph included?

- Submit only one (1) application.
- Finalists will be contacted for in-person interview.
- If you do not have a completed packet (i.e., letter of acceptance and/or transcripts), we will NOT contact you for the additional requirements. DO NOT DELAY sending in your application and essay!
